

Digital Escape Room: Space Explorer Training

FAQ Guide

- If you are having a hard time reading images please try using Zoom, hold the keys CTRL, SHIFT, and + together to increase size on screen.
- Puzzle 1- Initiate Launch
 - Did you see a code earlier that could be used here?
 - Should you go back and read the incoming Start transmission?
 - What is the founding date of NASA (month and year)?
- Puzzle 2- Star Chart 1
 - What sequence of colors tells you to stop and go?
 - Do you see anything hidden in the chart?
 - Have you connected any dots?
- Puzzle 3- Star Chart 2
 - Are you using the Directional Lock Key?
 - All answer letters should be capital with no spaces between.
 - Check to make sure you are looking at the correct stars.
- Puzzle 4- Object Identification
 - Open a new tab before searching in Google.
 - Try putting the word object before M#.
 - Make sure you are looking up who CATALOGED the objects.

- Puzzle 5- Morse Code Rover Message
 - Is the video working? (If not, please contact us at mlockard@cc-pl.org)
 - Listen carefully and more than once, it can be hard to tell the difference between a dash and a dot.
 - What is the essential ingredient to life? All lower case.
- Puzzle 6- Space Puzzle
 - Are you using the Color Code Key?
 - If they align FROM a star, what order should they be in?
 - What is the common order that these objects can be found in?
 - Open a new tab and Google their distance from the sun.
- Puzzle 7- Landing Procedures
 - This is not an interactive puzzle, the switches will not move.
 - Have you seen these symbols in an earlier puzzle? What order did you use then?
 - Answer uses the numbers to sides of the switches.
 - These are Astronomical Symbols that identify a planet or planetary object, what order do planets go in? Chart of Astronomical Symbols:
