## FAQ Guide

- If you are having a hard time reading images please try using Zoom, hold the keys CTRL, SHIFT, and + together to increase size on screen.
- Puzzle 1
  - Open a new tab before searching in Google, try to use the information in the crossword clue to assist in your research.
  - Choose the correct dropdown option, read the list carefully.
- Puzzle 2
  - Open a new tab before searching in Google, try to use the information in the crossword clue to assist in your research.
  - Choose the correct dropdown option, read the list carefully.
- Puzzle 3
  - What order should these colors go in? Is there a common order for these specific colors?
  - This is a type of pottery used in Ancient Greece that is often decorated with black figure paintings.
  - Answer should be entered in all lower case.
- Puzzle 4
  - Choose an item.
  - Open a new tab before searching in Google, try to look up what item from the word before looks like if you are unsure.
- Puzzle 5
  - Are you familiar with roman numerals?
  - Are there numbers associated with the letters and colors you saw before?
  - What order should you put the numbers in?
  - No spaces between numbers in the answer, seven digits.
- Artemis
  - What constellation is associated with a myth that features Artemis?
  - He was considered a great hunter by the Ancient Greeks.
  - What constellation has a belt of star and its brightest star is Rigel?
  - What beast slayed the hero from the previous question?
  - Which of these constellations sounds like it would be this animal?
  - Open a new tab before searching in Google, try to look looking these myths or questions up to assist your research.
- Athena
  - Did you open the link in a new tab? (if the link is not working, please contact us at [mlockard@cc-pl.org](mailto:mlockard@cc-pl.org))
  - Check the diagram from the puzzle to help answer some questions.
  - Open a new tab and try searching in Google.
  - What popular temple do we also have a duplicate of here in the US in Nashville?
  - What part of a temple would display artwork on the outside?

- What types of columns are there?
- Apollo
  - Think hard about things Apollo is associated with for the first one.
  - In the second one, the Tiber was one of these that ran through Rome.
  - Final riddle, what space object can we connect to myths and often create images out of by connect them like dots?
- Mars
  - What clue on the coin could we use to narrow down what Roman emperor this was?
  - Open a new tab to search in Google.
  - Can you read Roman numerals?
  - Once you have found the emperor, search for the date range for his reign.
  - Input the date range with no spaces, match the example.
- Venus
  - Caesar Shift ciphers use the alphabet as a key, then you will take the number given and shift up/left on the alphabet from the letter in the scrambled message to find the correct letter.
  - There are cipher decoders on the internet if you would like to open a new tab and look for one using Google.
  - All lower case and **two** words.
- Vulcan
  - Do you know Latin names for metals?
  - Use the provided hints to identify the metals, or use a Latin translator online.
  - Open a new tab to search in Google.
  - Input answers when you are giving him metals as all lower case.
  - Final question should be input all upper case with no spaces.
  - Where are the two letter symbols for each metal displayed?
- Hermes
  - Use the key on the map to help identify the god of a city and which have oracles.
  - Follow the directions provided my Hermes using the cardinal directions (North, East, South, and West).
  - Input city names in all lower case.
- Demeter
  - You will need to unscramble the plant names, you may be able to use the images below to help you guess what they are.
  - Open a new tab to use Google to look up the goddesses and their symbols.
  - Input answer as all upper case and no spaces.

  - Did you open the link in a new tab? (if the link is not working, please contact us at [mlockard@cc-pl.org](mailto:mlockard@cc-pl.org))
  - Make note of the symbols and the numbers on them before you start the puzzle.
  - Keep track of where each symbol will end before you complete it, the puzzle does not let you see a finished version.

- Input answer as top row left to right, middle row left to right, and bottom row left to right with no spaces, 9 digits.
- Neptune
  - Which symbol on the map matches up with the description of each point on the timeline?
  - Do you know the story of the Odyssey?
  - Open a new tab to search in Google if you are unsure.
  - Use the cardinal directions (North, East, South, and West) on the map to follow the route using the timeline and symbols.
  - Are you using the directional key?
  - Input all upper case with no spaces, 6 letters.
- Juno
  - Do you know this myth?
  - What hero did Hera make complete twelve labors?
  - Open a new tab in Google to search for the myth if you are unfamiliar.
  - What hero has his own movie from Disney?
  - Input first answer following the example with upper case letters and numbers with no spaces.
  - Input second answer as all lower case.
- Pluto
  - Did you open the link in a new tab? (if the link is not working, please contact us at [mlockard@cc-pl.org](mailto:mlockard@cc-pl.org))
  - When answering and choosing a door, click on it to see a link. Click that link to move on through the game.
  - If you answer incorrectly, click on the oops image to see a link. Click that link to return to previous question.
  - Final image does not have a link, return to the tab with the digital escape room.
  - You will answer the final question on Pluto's page in the digital escape room.
  - Input final answer in all lower case.
  - Open a new tab to search in Google if you are unsure of how to answer one of Pluto's questions, you may have to research the names presented as well as the Ancient Greek Underworld to get your answer.
- Final Zeus
  - Only check one box.
